SPECIAL NOTES

***Vessel will not be launched (or scheduled for launch) until all outstanding bills are paid in full.** Slips must be paid in full by March 31, 2018 or by the time of launching, which ever is sooner.

***All SEACOCKS must be in working condition so they may be closed upon launching.**

***Dock lines, fenders, batteries and shore cords must be aboard the boat prior to launching. Key and/or combinations must be left with the yard office.** If any of the above is not completed prior to launching, the boatyard may, at its discretion, either delay the launching, or supply whatever is necessary and the customer will be charged accordingly.

Boats not berthed at Brewer Ferry Point Marina will be provided courtesy dockage until the weekend immediately following launching. Boats remaining after this grace period will be charged transient rates. Alternate arrangements can be accommodated, when arranged in advance.

***Boat will not be launched until the area surrounding the boat is clean and clear of owner's launch preparation waste.** Owners will be charged if yard is required to do so in order to maintain launch schedules.

***Environmental and Safety Requirements** – vacuum sanders and other collection measures must be in place when doing any exterior hull work. The boatyard provides environmentally appropriate means for disposing of batteries, oil, and other wastes. Please contact staff for assistance.

***No outside labor or independent contractor is allowed on the premises unless prior permission is obtained from the yard office.** The yard will require proof of appropriate liability and worker's compensation insurance, along with proof of compliance with environmental and governmental regulations required for this property and business. A fee will be charged to the owner for the contractor's time and activities on the property. The yard office must be advised by the owner in advance of contractor's arrival. Please call the yard office to receive Subcontractor Rules.

***Payment for commissioning services is expected before the boat leaves the marina.**
