2018-2019 Shrink Wrap Boat Covering

Pricing includes all aspects of installation but does not include removal of cover or frame. **Shrink wrap rates do not include cover or frame removal.** All shrink wrap materials must be recycled. The marina will supply an appropriate number of shrink wrap recycle bags at \$20 apiece. Wickford Cove Marina is not responsible for cover- or frame-induced damages to paint, gelcoat, stanchions, lifelines, pulpits, pushpits, or any other vessel surfaces or attached structures.

SHRINK WRAP BASE PRICING *(please check one)*

- Up to 40' LOA (\$2.20/Sq. Ft)
- 40' to 50' LOA (\$2.35/Sq. Ft)
- Over 50' LOA (\$2.50/Sq. Ft)

**LOA includes all Vessel equipment overhanging the hull*

FAIRCLOUGH COVER

- Install owner-supplied cover and frame – (variable rate based on cover design and deck layout)
(50% upon installation, 50% upon removal)

ADDITIONAL CHARGES

(Please check applicable items)

- Reusable Door..... \$75.00
- Powerboat Bridge or Flybridge..... \$265.00
- Powerboat Tuna Tower..... \$330.00
- Sailboat with Mast In..... add \$7.00/LF
- Cover to Waterline..... add \$4.00/LF

EXAMPLES

Powerboat:	
48' LOA x 14.5' Max. Beam = (696 SF @ \$2.35/SF) =	\$1,635.60
Add door @ \$75.00	\$75.00
TOTAL (including tax on materials)	\$1,710.60
Sailboat:	
32' LOA x 9.25' Max. Beam = (296 SF @ \$2.20/SF) =	\$651.20
Add door @ \$75.00	\$75.00
Add mast in @ \$7.00/LF	\$224.00
TOTAL (including tax on materials)	\$950.20

Note: Removal and/or lowering of canvas, appendages, antennas, electronics masts etc. is often required in order to minimize the chance of damage occurring while a vessel is protected from the elements by a winter cover. These items not removed by the customer will be removed by WCM at our customary rates. If an owner insists on leaving canvas, appendages, antennas, electronics masts installed, WCM will not assume responsibility if these items are damaged by a winter cover. Winter covers can apply significant loads to rails, stanchions, and other exposed appendages and WCM will take every pre-caution to protect a boat's extremities and minimize the chance for excessive loads and/or damage to a vessel. However, WCM cannot guarantee any boat's ability to withstand the pressure a winter cover can impose on its appendages and, therefore, will not be held liable for resulting damage.
