Spring Checklist Terms and Conditions

In addition to the **GENERAL MARINA RULES AND CONDITIONS**, the terms of which shall apply to all contracts and agreements made between the Marina and a Vessel Owner and are hereby incorporated, the following terms shall apply to the Marina's Spring Checklist:

LAUNCH WEEK: The Marina will make every effort to launch a vessel during the desired launch week. However, weather and other factors can affect the launch schedule and create delays. Once a vessel is launched, please plan to leave vessel with the Marina for one week to allow time for completion of any remaining commissioning- or service-related tasks. If no commissioning services are required, owners should plan to move their vessels within two days of launch, per the terms listed on the Spring Checklist. Launch week requests are processed in the order in which they're received. If the requested launch week is full, the Marina will schedule launch for the next available time.

LAUNCH READINESS: Please ensure vessel is ready to launch on Monday of the scheduled launch week. If vessel is not ready to launch on Monday of the scheduled launch week, vessel's launch will be pushed to the next available week. Any costs associated with moving vessel out of the way of others will be the owner's responsibility. In peak spring launch periods, missing a launch week due to a lack of preparedness can equate to a launch delay of a week or more. Vessel owners should prioritize land-based spring commissioning tasks well in advance of their scheduled launch week. Please have dock lines and fenders accessible when boat is scheduled to launch. Batteries must be aboard, charged, and connected prior to launch.

ACCOUNTSTANDING: All accounts must be paid in full (zero-dollar balance) prior to vessel launch. The Marina will not launch a vessel until the associated account is current.

VESSEL ACCESS: Please ensure the Marina has companionway access information prior to the vessel's scheduled launch week. Thru-hulls, packing glands, and transducers all need to be inspected for water-tightness when vessel is launched.

VESSEL ARRIVAL VIA TRAILER: Vessels arriving for unloading via private or commercial trailer must be scheduled in advance with the Marina. Please supply contact information for transport company, if vessel is arriving via commercial trailer.
